Reaching Lisbon

The best way to get to Lisbon from abroad is by airplane, with direct connections to a large number of destinations. The list of airlines flying to Lisbon can be found at the airport's website, <https://www.aeroportoisboa.pt/en/lis/flights-destinations/airlines/airlines-and-destinations>, as well as the list of cities with direct connections, <https://www.aeroportoisboa.pt/en/lis/flights-destinations/destinations/destinations-map>.

Venue

The meeting will take place at Instituto Superior Técnico (IST) - University of Lisbon, Alameda campus in Lisbon, at *Av. Rovisco Pais*, 1049-001 Lisbon. The whole meeting will take place at the Congress Centre, at *Pavilhão de Civil*, which is building #2 on the map at http://grow.tecnico.ulisboa.pt/wp-content/uploads/2016/03/Campus_IST.jpg. You can enter directly to the Congress Centre from the street (*Rua Alves Redol*), or from within the campus, in which case you need to go down two floors after you enter *Pavilhão de Civil*.

WiFi

IST is part of the EDUROAM network, so colleagues from other European Universities that are part of this network will have direct access to the WiFi network.

In any case, WiFi access will be available for all participants during the meeting. Instructions for access will be given at the meeting.

Registration

The contribution to the expenses concerning the organisation of the meeting is 120 €. It is intended to cover exclusively meeting expenses, i.e., it covers coffee breaks, lunches, and dinner on Thursday, Feb. 2nd, 2017. Accompanying persons may attend dinner, upon capacity availability, by paying 60 €.

Accommodation

We suggest that you book rooms at *Holiday Inn* (the hotel marked with 1 on the map), which is just across the street near to the building where the meeting will take place. Another possibility is *Hotel Turim Alameda* (marked 2 on the map), which is also a couple of minutes away.

For these hotels, their prices (breakfast and all taxes included) range usually between 50 € and 90 € for a single room, and 60 € and 100 € for a double one. The prices under the contract with IST are the same as the ones when booking via the Internet, hence, we recommend that you book directly via the Internet. In any case, do not hesitate to contact us, if you need any assistance on this matter.
